This course will cover:

- What a teacher does: key features of teaching, assessment and learning across Foundation stage and key stages 1 & 2
- What the children do; in class, school visits, extra curricular activities
- Things to look for when on school placement: how teachers plan, work with others; manage children
- What's next? Opportunities for careers advice; advice on application and interview for ITT courses

You can apply if:

- o You match the target group (Men)(Black or Ethnic Minority)
- o You have GCSE Maths and English at Grade C or above, or equivalent, or are making arrangements for obtaining them
- o You have not already applied for Initial Teacher Training (ITT)
- o You want to find out more about teaching so that you can decide whether to apply to ITT
- o You are eligible to enter teacher training within 1 year of attendance
- o You hold a TDA registration number or will obtain one. This can be done by registering with the Training Development Agency (TDA) online at www.tda.gov.uk or by telephoning the Teaching Information Line on 0845 6000 991.)

The course is open to both Graduates and those interested in pursuing an Under Graduate route.
